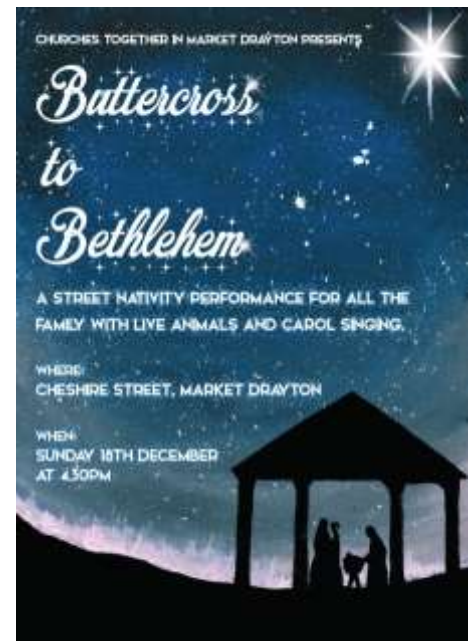

Our Vision Statement

In Christ's name, St Mary's seeks to Welcome all, to Lead people to Christ, to Nurture the faith and to Engage and Serve the community'

- be self-aware and have a well-developed understanding of their strengths and weaknesses;

- be able to lead and develop the worship and prayer life of the parish in conjunction with others;
- be able to continue to foster our excellent, strong and extensive ecumenical relationships outside the Parish: actively participating in, and with, Market Drayton Churches Together, the Deanery, local institutions, civic authorities, the Armed Services and community activities.
- be an effective communicator



Whilst the above reflects the work of any Anglican vicar, the Vicar of Market Drayton faces some unusual challenges, ie. large and diverse congregations, a wide range of church activities, institutional and civic responsibilities and the strategic position of the Parish within the Deanery and Diocese.

We seek commitment to the distinctive characteristics of the congregations and the development of our vision. We therefore invite you to consider how you might rise to these challenges and what personal qualities and particular gifts you will bring to the Parish.

Bearing these points in mind, we are praying for someone who:

- has the energy, ability and faith to give spiritual leadership and encouragement to large and diverse congregations;
- has well developed interpersonal and leadership skills;
- has the desire to identify and supervise new leaders and release them into ministry;
- recognises the need for engagement with families and provides us with the experience to build this rapidly;
- has the ability to foster teamwork within the staff, PCC and congregation;
- has experience of alternative church, its challenges and opportunities to reach out to the wider community;
- understands the way home groups can be used to instruct, teach and cherish people outside the main services;
- has pastoral gifts to engage with and support individuals in the congregation and the community at significant points in their lives;
- will challenge and nourish theological reflection on local, national and international issues.



This is a demanding job, but we believe a highly rewarding one, for someone seeking a new challenge. We are looking for someone who will help to discern and lead energetically into the future God has planned for us. While the demands and expectations are high, the congregations are active and supportive.

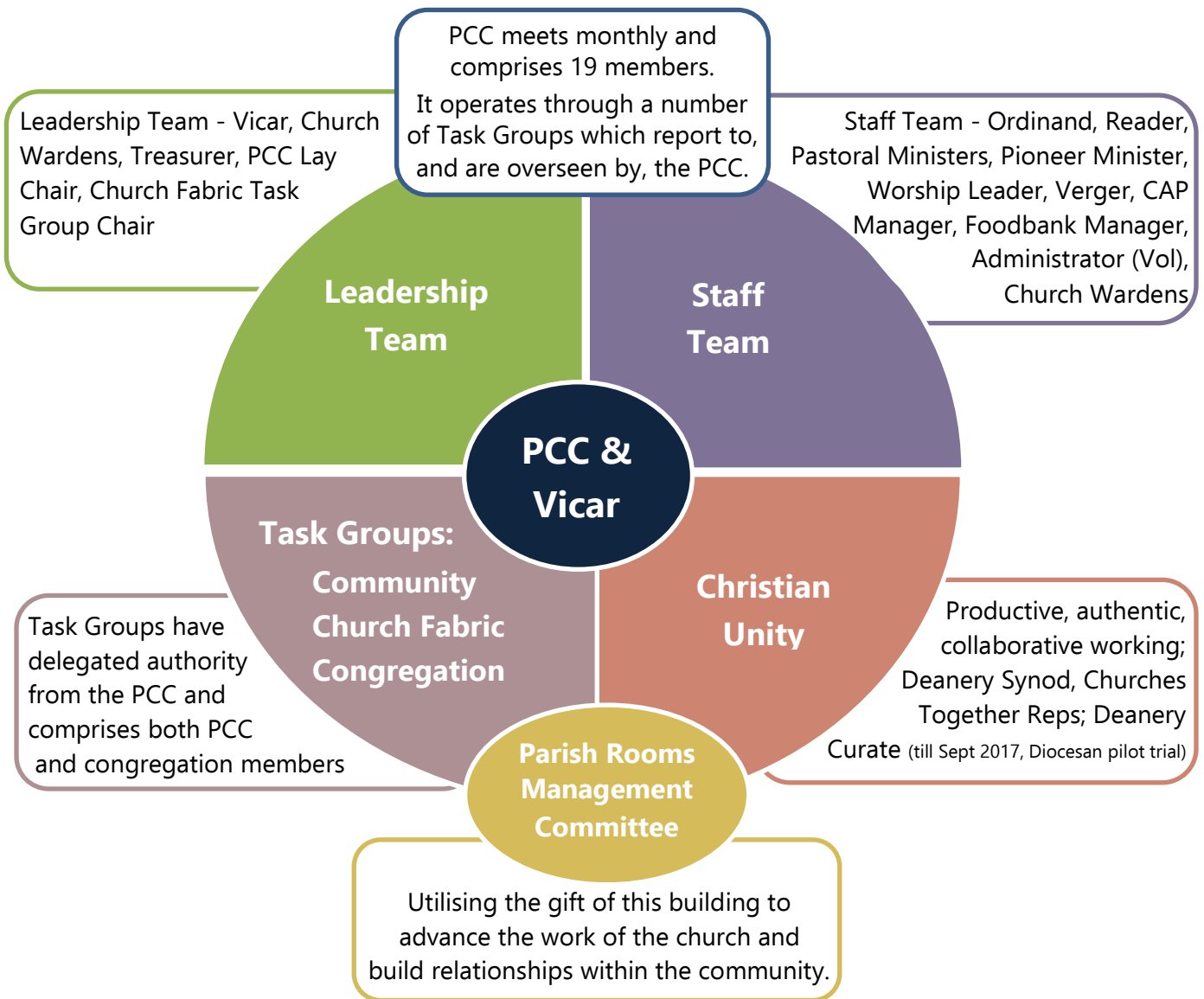
- our worshipping community comprises 347 people

- 30% of members live in the parish
- 48% of members live in Market Drayton but not the parish
- 22% of members live outside of Market Drayton
- The population of the parish is only approximately 5,000



About Market Drayton

Market Drayton is located in the top right hand corner of Shropshire – a typical English shire, with lots of history, oak trees and farms. It is also within easy reach of Birmingham, Manchester, and Chester and J15 of the M6 20 minutes away. London is an hour and a quarter away via the Pendolino train service from Stafford.



Several large employers operate in Market Drayton. Müller Yogurt & Desserts and Palethorpes (part of Northern Foods) – both food based, and a Prison. Market Drayton is a dormitory town with a higher than average ratio of elementary occupation workers.

The population of Market Drayton is approx 12,000, we are the third largest market town in Shropshire. 60% of the population are of working age, with 30% under 25 and 18.8% over 65. It is worth noting that despite the beautiful surroundings Market Drayton ranks in the top 20% most deprived areas in England (ref: Index of Multiple Deprivation).



Over the last few years, the consumer experience in the town has been augmented with several national chains such as Wetherspoons, Argos and Homebase. Whilst this has enhanced the variety of stores, the Wednesday market and the Saturday farmers market are still the jewels in the crown of the town - as is, the now national brewery, Joules.

St Mary's Parish occupies the eastern half of the town, with a range of housing from new executive housing, 1960's council housing; over half the houses were built before the 20th century. St Mary's population does not reflect the town's, with an older church family, but we have seen steady growth in new church members, albeit not at the younger end. This is a challenge that the PCC has targeted to address through the

appointment of a families worker, linking into our large Messy Church family, CAP, Foodbank and Who Let the Dads Out as well as the schools and Uniformed youth groups. Market Drayton has a large number of ex armed services personnel who were based at Tern Hill camp or Shawbury. Within the town, there is one secondary school, though many students are bussed to other schools in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and Staffordshire. There is an infant and junior school and a primary school with many village primary schools in surrounding areas.



Part of the Shropshire Union canal network, St Marys has active Boaters Fellowship links and extensive walking routes.
