It's been a while since we spent some time reflecting on our Vision and Purpose at St Mary's. As a reminder our Purpose is based upon Jesus' 'Great Commission' to his followers, at the end of Matthew's gospel: to go and make disciples of all nations. We express this in our own way: that our Purpose is to enable people to know Jesus. love, Jesus and live for Jesus. As we seek to do this together as a church, our hope and Vision is that we will see our town transformed by the love of Christ. Underpinning both our Purpose and Vision are our values, the characteristics that we want to live out as a church family. These values are integral to who and how we want to be. Most weeks, these values are displayed on screen at the 10.30 service, as we pray our Vision Prayer together; but just to remind you (!), we want to be a church that is: Passionate for God; Outwardlooking; Generous; Loving; Welcoming and Courageous.

This week saw the festival celebrating the birth of our patron saint, St Mary. So it seems a good opportunity to reflect on how she modelled the values, that – as a church that bears her name – we seek to emulate. Mary longed to see God's promises fulfilled and put herself completely and wholeheartedly at God's disposal (Passionate for God). She welcomed the Christ Child into her life, providing for him and pouring upon him her love and care (Welcoming, Loving, Generous). All of this she did whilst not knowing how things would work out – but knowing that it would come at considerable cost to herself (Courageous). But she did it anyway, because she recognised that the world needed a Saviour, who would bring God's mercy and justice (Outward-looking). And so, we keep praying:

Open our eyes, Lord;
unblock our ears, Lord;
put your words on our lips, Lord;
set our hearts on fire
to build your Kingdom
in our lives; through our church; in our town.
In Jesus' name.

We are advertising for a part-time Children and Families Worker - full details are on our Website. Please pass on this information who is a committed Christian and might be interested in




working with children and families. The closing date for applications is **30th September**. Please pray that the right people will apply and that those interviewing will be guided by the Lord in the decisions they make.

Finally in our Dementia series

Encouraging Someone with Dementia to Communicate



- speak clearly and slowly, using short sentences
- make eye contact with the person when they are talking or asking questions
- encourage them to join in the conversation where possible
- give them simple choices avoid creating complicated choices or options for them
- acknowledge what they have said, even if they do not answer your question or what they say seems out of context
- use other ways to communicate such as rephrasing questions because they cannot answer in the way they used to.
