Do not be afraid!

Fear is one of the trickiest emotions that all people experience. On the one hand 'healthy' fear can guide us to act in ways that are undoubtedly beneficial – we won't cross a road full of fast-moving traffic until there is a break, big enough, for us to proceed safely. 'Unhealthy' fear, on the other hand, can be so powerful that we won't do things that we want to do and would enjoy – like not going to a friend's party because we know their house has spiders in it. Finding the right balance so that our fears stay in the 'healthy' and out of the 'unhealthy' court is never easy. However, our readings this week can help us get this right!

Archangel Gabriel, almost always a totally unexpected, intimidating and surprising visitor, was quick to reassure Mary not to be afraid – neither of him nor of the news he was bringing, which was straight from God. A healthy fear of God means we have a deep, heartfelt reverence and awe for Him – such fear helps us to walk in His way and to follow His word. Mary is a wonderful example to us of a vulnerable, young woman placing her life at God's disposal and trusting that He would stick with her whatever happened. God loves us, just as he loves Mary, and really doesn't want us to walk in a paralysing, unhealthy fear of Him or anything else.

In Jesus we see what God looks like when He becomes fully human – the perfect example to follow as we make choices in our own lives. Paul is very direct in his instructions to the Philippian Christians: unite in Jesus; be full of the Holy Spirit; love as He does; and work humbly for the benefit of everyone else. This is great advice for us as well. Can we shine like stars as we let God work His way in our lives to build His Kingdom? We don't need to be afraid to do this because, as Paul wrote to the Romans, neither death nor life, neither angels or demons nor anything else in all creation can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
