So what does a present need in order to have these qualities. Perhaps I can make three suggestions as to what makes a "perfect present". 1. For us it is the most valuable gift we will ever be offered. <u>Is it needed</u>? From the verse above it is obvious that it is the essential gift that everybody needs. For it is through this wonderful gift of Jesus that our relationship with God is restored and that we have life everlasting with Him. What a perfect gift to receive and accept from God!
