Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." (John 14.27)

Out of all the verses of the Bible, we have chosen this one verse for the homepage of our website. It stands without comment or explanation among all the usual admin and information: service times, where to find us, our policies, and latest news.

Do we ever give thought to why this verse is so special to us? As we hear it read in our services today, perhaps reflect on what it means to you.

We often feel we live in an age of stress. The pace of life is accelerating, hurtling towards who knows what. People are left exhausted physically, emotionally, spiritually in trying to keep up. Oh, to step off the hamster wheel. Some seek refuge in ways that might work as a temporary escape, but can be self-destructive. Perhaps more wholesome is to take time immersing yourself in the natural world. Until you have to get back on the wheel.

The peace Jesus gives is, *'not as the world gives'*. His peace is peace with God, because on the cross he removed the barriers we have put up between us and God. This peace he brings into our very being. It is not dependent on our situation, nor on whatever anyone else might or might not do. It comes from his presence through the Holy Spirit. Because, as he promised, he is with us always! And we are constantly reminded that we are in a loving relationship with God, revealed to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

I pray that anyone visiting our church will find this peace for themselves, that they will see it shining in our lives, in our worship, in everything we do. For this is not a secret to keep to ourselves, but to share with all. God loves you.

In our first Bible reading from Acts 16, we heard how Paul brought the gospel to Europe in Philippi. Several years later, in his letter to the Christians there, he wrote reminding them of the joy they now have, because '*The peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*' (Phil 4.7) May you be assured that, 'the God of peace will be with you' (Phil 4.9) – always!


