Having a great time. Wish you were here! Words we probably see less often nowadays. Friends on holiday are more likely to send us a WhatsApp message than a holiday postcard. How things change.

Writing postcards always used to be big part of family holidays. There would be the choosing of appropriate cards, perhaps, even, a cheeky one. But on the whole: bright, colourful, perfect weather scenes of beaches, countryside, or famous landmark. Then there was the question; would we be home before our cards arrived? A postcard can only give a small representation of our holiday destination. A beautiful scene reduced onto a piece of card measuring about 4 x 6 inches. How can it ever do it full justice? And what about the sounds of the sea, or the fragrance of exotic foods? All that splendour reduced to a postcard.

There is something postcard-like to our Bible readings this week. Both Paul and John have attempted, in just a few words, to encapsulate the vastness, the awesome, amazing splendour of God. John reports the leftover crumbs from five small rolls and two small fish can fill twelve baskets. How do we get our minds around that? Paul encourages his readers to try and contemplate, 'how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ'. The capacity of my mind to understand is just postcard-sized compared to the infinite vastness of his love.

This underlies one of our favourite songs at Messy Church: 'Our God is a Great Big God'. 'He is higher than a skyscraper, deeper than a submarine, wider than the universe and beyond my wildest dreams'. We pray that they will catch a glimpse of Jesus' amazing love for them. Probably, we all hold people in our hearts who we long to come to know the love Jesus has for them. We may have been praying for them for a long time. Nothing we do or say seems to work. But hold on to Paul's words, that God, 'is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or

The disciples by the Sea of Galilee, hadn't a clue what to do in what seemed an impossible situation. Instead they had to trust Jesus. All they had to do was let Jesus take control. It was that simple. Can we, dare we, do the same?


#### Messy Church
