#### Meals Matter

When I was young, our family mostly ate our meals together at the kitchen table. On Sundays, we sat round the table in the dining room for lunch but were allowed to have tea on our laps in front of the television. Around the meal table all manner of important family discussions took place. We were a large family and there was never a shortage of topics and everyone was able and comfortable to have their say. Debate, dialogue, disagreement, airing, sharing, loving and caring all took place round the table - I think I was very lucky to have a family that was able to work this way without too much conflict. From street parties to state banquets, meals are a great way for people from different places to find common ground for celebration, diplomacy and simply getting to know each other better.

Jesus loved parties and meals - he said yes to the invitations and took the opportunity they gave him to teach about better ways of doing things. This week he is at the sabbath meal hosted by a prominent Pharisee. This is a big deal: where would the local celebrity preacher (Jesus) fit in? To participants it mattered a lot where people sat, who spoke, who was nearer the host, who was invited and who was left out. There were a lot left out - poor people, women, children and servants - they might be there to serve but not join in the fun. Jesus is having none of this. For him meals are about giving people the food they need and not reinforcing status, power and social boundaries. In His kingdom the key priority is for the have-nots to share the same opportunities and benefits as the haves. It is a kingdom where there is enough for everybody and where everyone can enter and sit down together.

I am sure that it is no accident that the meal Jesus left us is simple, nourishing, healing, transforming and available to everyone. The bread and the wine remind us of Him, bring Him into our lives and us into His kingdom.

Read Easy offers free, confidential, one-to-one reading tuition to over

18s. We are all volunteers who are passionate about reading and about supporting those who want to learn. We understand how difficult it can be to ask for this kind of help but also recognise how difficult it is to negotiate life without secure reading skills.

Prospective readers simply have to make a phone call to Claire, our Team Leader (07941 515 220) and she will arrange a face-to-face meeting. Readers are then paired with a coach who they will meet twice a week for half an hour, in a mutually agreed public space. Our coaches are all trained and DBS checked and will work at a reader's own pace to help them improve their reading skills. We currently have coaches trained and ready to go in Market Drayton. We are also keen to find new volunteers, either as reading coaches or as members of our Management Team. Again, a phone call to Claire or myself will get this process started. No previous experience is necessary as full training and lots of support will be provided.
